Tokyo is the political and economic center of Japan, a convergence of business, government, research, and universities, as well as cultural opportunities.

These Summer programs offer an opportunity to achieve proficiency in Japanese. With a student-teacher ratio of 11 to 1, KCP serves over 500 students each year with an English-speaking staff to provide language support, and special tutorials. And, each program provides time to broaden your experience in Japan's culture with excursions to cultural spots, museums, palaces, theaters, and corporations.

Summer Program

A total immersion Intensive Japanese Language Course of the same duration as a semester yet short enough to fit between an academic year. The language course is offered at 6 levels with special emphasis on a balanced language education program that stresses the 4 most important communication skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

Summer Short Term Program

A summer program with a schedule more convenient for students attending universities in the United States. The program is met with great enthusiasm from students and recent college graduates alike. The program includes balanced language instruction, exciting excursions, cultural activities, and a lower cost.

Japanese Language and Business (4 weeks)

Students and graduates considering career paths in Asian relations will gain valuable practical information and experiences. Spend one month in Tokyo and improve Japanese language proficiency while developing an understanding of Japanese culture and business through class lessons, outside activities, business lectures, and company visits,

Japanese Language and Anime/Manga in Japan (4 weeks)

Spend a month in Tokyo and learn the Japanese language while you study Japanese society through the lens of Japanese Anime and Manga. Planned site visits include the Yonezawa Memorial Library of Manga and Subcultures, Akihabara (a shopping area for electronic and animation devices), Odaiba (a collection of life-sized Gundam), Ghibli Museum, and a couple of anime/manga-related retail stores. Also included is a practical lesson in drawing anime and manga at a local technical college.

Eligibility

For full time undergraduate and postgraduate students, and other adults. It is strongly recommended that students enrolling in our regular summer and summer-short term programs should have completed one semester of Japanese or have a working knowledge of Hiragana and Katakana. There are no language prerequisites for the summer 4-week specialized programs.

Academic Credit

Summer and Summer Short-Term programs:

You may acquire one year or more of academic Japanese language credit per term. If you attend a college or university, or plan to return to school, apply through one of our sponsor schools. On successful completion of the program, courses will appear on your sponsor institution's transcript and may be used as transfer credit. It is up to each student to determine transferability of credit.

Four week Summer programs

You will receive a KCP grade report; however you will need to contact your college or university to arrange for hours to be used as transfer credit. (60 contact hours of language instruction, and 40 plus contact hours specialized lecture/site visits.)

Program Costs Include:

- Tuition, fees, and textbooks
- On-site orientation

- Dormitory or homestay participants include airport pick-up at Narita Airport on arrival date, most utilities, and transportation between lodging and school.

Personal expenses and travel to and from Japan are not included. Airfare depends on when you travel. Summer and Summer Short-Term Students should budget \$1,500 to \$2,500 for meals and personal expenses. 4 Week Program Students should budget \$750 to \$1,000 for meals and personal expenses.

Financial Aid

Academic credit and financial aid may be available through sponsor and affiliate universities and you should be able to apply Federal and State financial aid to these Summer programs.

Passport and Visa

All students must have a valid passport. Because of a visa exemption arrangement between the U.S. and Japan, students can stay fewer than 90 days (one semester) without being issued a visa.

Refund Policy

If a student is not accepted to the program, all payments less a \$50 *processing fee* will be returned. If KCP receives written confirmation of withdrawal more than 60 days before the program starts, all payments, minus the non-refundable *application deposit* of \$350, will be returned. If we receive written confirmation of withdrawal 45 to 60 days before the program begins, 50% of the program fee will be refunded. If payment has not been made, 50% of the program fee is due. No refunds will be made if withdrawal occurs 45 days or less before the program start date. If payment has not been made, 100% of the program fee is due.

AGREEMENT AND RELEASE

1. I release KCP International Japanese Language School and KCP International USA, Inc. (collectively "KCP"), and sponsor and their officers and agents from any and all claims and causes of action for damage to or loss of property, personal illness or injury, or death, arising out of any travel or activity conducted by or under the control of KCP or sponsor. I further agree to reimburse KCP, sponsor, or any Japanese host family with whom I/my son or daughter stays during the program for any damage to property or injury to persons connected with KCP, sponsor, or a Japanese host family caused by me/my son or daughter.
2. I accept full responsibility and will indemnify and hold KCP, sponsor, and any Japanese host family harmless from any damage to or loss of property or personal injury to any third party arising out of any alleged action on the part of myself/my son or daughter.
3. In the event of illness or injury to me/my son or daughter, I hereby authorize any officer of KCP to secure any necessary treatment, including the administration of an anesthetic and surgery.
4. I give permission and accept full responsibility for any expenses incurred while I/my son or daughter travels independently on weekends or academic holidays during my/his/her period of study at the KCP program site. I agree that neither sponsor, KCP, nor any program staff or Japanese host family is responsible for the participant while on an independent side trip.
5. KCP is hereby authorized to distribute my/my son or daughter's name, address, and telephone number to other participants in the program prior to departure.
6. I understand that KCP sometimes uses photographs of program participants in its program catalogs and other publicity materials. I authorize KCP to use photographs in which the student is pictured for promotional purposes.
7. I have read KCP's refund policy in the program catalog and agree to abide by it. Further, I agree that unless I have made specific arrangements with either KCP or sponsor to the contrary, all fees will be paid in full prior to departure for the program.
8. I certify that all statements made in this application for a KCP program are correct and true.
9. I understand that, as part of my application, I may need to obtain a letter of good health from a licensed physician stating that I am in satisfactory health, capable of traveling to Japan, and fit to attend the language study program.
10. I understand that KCP-USA will not be making the final acceptance decision, and that the acceptance decision will be made by KCP-Japan.
11. Studying at KCP is not like studying at a university or college in your home country. Japanese traditions run deep at KCP. Policies, procedures, curriculum and support services will probably be unlike any you have experienced at home. You must be open-minded and respectful of KCP traditions. There is no room for disrespect of faculty, staff or any students from other countries. You represent your home country and as such, your conduct during your stay in Japan must be exemplary. Your primary purpose for attending KCP should be dedicating yourself to increasing your proficiency in the Japanese language. Only then can you truly experience the breadth of the Japanese culture. If you are able to be respectful of the Japanese culture and traditions, you are encouraged to proceed with your application.
12. I understand that I am required to maintain health insurance coverage during my stay in Japan. I further agree that I will be responsible for my own medical care while abroad. By signing below I indicate that I will have insurance during the entire duration of my stay in Japan.
13. I certify that I am in good physical and mental health and that I do not suffer from any special mental or physical condition that would prevent me from successfully taking part in the KCP program.
14. I understand that any information collected by KCP in the registration and application material from Student may be shared by Sponsor, or Student's home university, but only to the extent that it is important for the KCP registration and application process.
