Modified Hiragana

DAKUTEN is a mark which is added to hiragana and katakana that changes the consonant sound into a voiced one. The following shows the changes:



HANDAKUTEN is a small circular mark which is added to hiragana and katakana that begins with "h" which changes the "h" sound into a "p" sound.



Modified Hiragana

YOON are hiragana or katakana characters which end in "i" with small versions of や (ya), ϕ (yu), ζ (yo). The "i" sound is dropped, resulting in a contracted sound. Thus, みょう is pronounced "myō," which means "strange" or "unusual." The word みよう (miyō) means "point of view".
